	fhoireann scoile san áireamh. Níl sé seo ag teastáil ón dá Bhord ach is
	fadhb leanúnach í seo. Táim ag iarraidh ar thuistí áit parceála a aimsiú
	taobh amuigh agus siúl isteach.
	I would like to remind parents that Muintir Chrónáin have instructed us that
	cars are not permitted through the gates of Áras Chrónáin. This includes
	after school activities. Children may be walked through the pedestrian gate
	beside the main gate or through the gate at the back of the Áras from
	Orchard Road.
	We are beginning our fourth week back in school and it is clear, even at this
	early stage in the year, that there are a number of parents who are not abiding
	by this rule. Parents are parking at the Aras and seem to be ignoring
	reminders and texts from the school. I am also shocked to say that some

	incidents of verbal abuse towards members of Muintir Chrónáin have been reported to the school. Our relationship with our landlords, Muintir Chrónáin, is extremely important to us. The strong, positive relationship between Gaelscoil na Camóige and Muintir Chrónáin over the years, since the foundation of our school in 1993, is one that we are proud of and wish to maintain. If parents continue to park at the Áras or park on the driveway at the gates, there is a chance that the gates will be closed to all traffic, including Naíonra parents and school staff. Neither the Board of Muintir Chrónáin nor the Board of Gaelscoil na Camóige wants to resort to these measures. However, this problem has been ongoing and we are pleading with parents to park outside the school and to walk in.
