Children who should not attend school

If your child is in one of the following categories, they should not attend school -

- Children who have been diagnosed with Covid-19
- Children who have been in close contact with a person who has been diagnosed with Covid-19
- Children who have a suspected case of Covid-19 and the outcome of the test is pending
- Children who have been in contact with a person who has a suspected case of Covid-19 and the outcome of the test is pending
- Children with underlying health conditions who have been directed by a medical professional not to attend school
- Children who have returned home after travelling abroad and must self-isolate for a period of 14 days
- Children who are generally unwell

Common symptoms of coronavirus include:

- <u>a fever (high temperature 38 degrees Celsius or above)</u>
- <u>a cough</u> this can be any kind of cough, not just dry
- <u>shortness of breath</u> or breathing difficulties
- <u>loss or change to your sense of smell or taste</u> this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

	As a school we strongly advise that children should wear their school uniforms or tracksuits <u>only for school related activities.</u> Uniforms or tracksuits should be taken off straight after the child arrives home from school for the day. They should not be worn in after-school facilities, shops, during after-school activities, etc. Homework Club and other afterschool activities cannot be facilitated at the moment. Toys and other items from home are not permitted in the school.
