Data is available to teachers, allowing them to identify strengths and weaknesses. Children enjoyed using the trial version last year and we are looking forward to adding Mangahigh.com to our classrooms and homes this year. <u>There will be a</u> <u>cost of 4 euro per child, to be paid through Aladdin</u> . Teachers and children are looking forward to using this extra fantastic resource in the teaching of Maths.

Leirítear meas don scoil nuair a chaitear na héadaí scoile, agus cuireann éadaí scoile go mór le mórtas cine is ceantair sna páistí. Huge thanks to SNA Bríd for arranging and overseeing the upkeep of the library, which is much loved by the children. This electronic book/library tracking system was selected and purchased to help oversee and co-ordinate a graded reading programme called 'Accelerated Reading'.
	Many thanks to CAIRDE who have fundraised and helped pay the subscription for A.R.
	Children from Rang 2-Rang 6 are tested at the beginning of the year (Star Test) which identifies their reading and comprehension ability. They then choose books from our A.R

Library, suited to their individual ability, to read and answer online quizzes. They are motivated online, to read, and can track their own progress. The programme is hugely beneficial for the teachers, as the children's progress is tracked easily online. The children are Star tested again twice during the year. The results of these tests, are a great help to teachers and Special Ed.Team, as the system highlights specific areas of difficulty for each individual child, and greatly helps us tackle these areas. Children are permitted to take the A.R books home, so that their reading is not interrupted. The class teachers will keep a log of books that are sent home with children. Please make sure that these books are not mislaid and are always in your child's bag every day going to school. If a book is mislaid, the parent will be required to purchase another copy.
<i>Children are not permitted to complete the online quizzes at home for various reasons.</i> <i>The license purchased is a school license only. Also, it is essential that the quizzes be done</i> <i>in school, to ensure accurate results.</i>
The A.R programme is a wonderful addition to the teaching and learning in our school. All books are sanitized before returning to the library.

Homework keeps parents informed of what and how their child is learning, allows parents to spend time reading and helping their child, and helps parents to understand their child's abilities and skills.
