Cairde Whatsapp Rules and Regs

(These rules were discussed and agreed to with the Cairde officers, CLP's and the school in 2019)

- This whatsapp is created by parents, and is separate to the school and to the Board of Management. The Board of Management does not accept responsibility for any messages posted.
- CLP Whatsapp group is a forum to share factual information about Cairde fundraising and day to day advice.
- It is not a forum for complaint.
- Whatsapp is not to be used to share photos, animations, GIFs
- Children's or teacher's names must not be used
- -It is an app for information only. Opinions or comparisons must not be shared. The information provided is from parent to parent. This information may not be accurate and is not the official form of communication used by the school. The Aladdin App is the school's official means of communication.
- It is every individual parent's decision to be on Whatsapp. It is not obligatory. Whatsapp can be used to share information about such things as school activities, queries about uniform, school tours, etc
- Be mindful of the time/day whatsapp messages are posted.
- Always contact the school for any urgent concerns
- -Remember to be respectful when posting messages. The forum is for sharing factual information only. If a conversation develops with a negative tone, the Admin will have no choice other than to close down the comments.
- Comparing children's work on Whatsapp is not permitted. This causes stress amongst parents. Children develop and grow at their own pace. Any concerns about your child's progress should always be brought to the class teacher.
- Whatsapp is a very useful tool, and is helpful in our busy lives. However, we should not rely too heavily on it. If mistakes are made, i.e. child goes to school in tracksuit rather than uniform in error, this is part of life and occasional mistakes are ok. We all learn from mistakes.
- Whatsapp may make life easier at times, but it is not essential.
