Scrúdúithe Caighdéanaithe/ Standardised Testing	Mar is eol daoibh, is am gnóthach í Mí Bealtaine sa scoil, nuair a bhíonn measúnaithe ar siúl ag na múinteoirí ranga. Measúnuithe darbh ainm Scrúdú DromConrach atá i gceist do R1- R6. Déanann na Naíonáin meascán de Belfield Assessments agus measúnuithe ranga. Tá sé tábhachtach go bhfuil tuiscint ag tuismitheoirí faoina scrúduithe seo agus iarrtar ar gach tuiste an doiciméad ceangailte " Your child & Standardised Testing" a léamh. At times, too much attention given to the tests and to the results, (high or low) can make a child feel under stress or pressured to do better. Please also note that standardised testing is just one method of assessment used by the teachers. <u>It is essential that children are in attendance</u>. Please talk to the class teacher if you know that your child will miss a day, to try to ensure that these tests are not missed. We cannot guarantee that your child will have an opportunity to sit the test, if they are absent.
